



PLAYTIME CLASS

DAILY SCHEDULE – ROOM 1

ARRIVAL 9:00-9:15

Children enter and are greeted by the teachers who help them to make a gradual transition from home to school. Children wash their hands and gather for an opening circle activity.

GREETING TIME 9:15-9:25

During this group time on the rug, a teacher leads the children in daily activities, introduce the star helper of the day, and introduce the weekly theme activities.

ACTIVITY HOUR 9:25-10:25

Children, led by their own needs and interests, may participate individually or in small groups in teacher-directed or open-ended activities in the following learning centers: blocks, playdough, dramatic play, housekeeping, table toys, easel painting, art, science discovery, sand and water tables, and language arts. Teachers encourage the children to sample different areas and daily activities.

CLEAN UP 10:25-10:30

A five-minute alert is given so the children may finish up their activities. Everyone helps clean up.

SNACK TIME 10:30-10:45

Hands are washed. Children sit with their assigned table teacher and classmates for a nutritious snack and possible small group activities.

CIRCLE TIME 10:45-11:00

During this group time on the rug, a teacher leads the children in language development activities such as stories, discussions, fingerplays, and songs.

ACTIVE PHYSICAL PLAY & DISMISSAL 11:00-11:30

If the weather is fine, the children may choose from the following outdoor activities on the fenced playground: nature exploration, riding toys, climbing, sandbox, ball games, and chalk drawing. During inclement weather, the children may choose from the following activities in the gymnasium: musical circle games, parachute games, obstacle course, ball skills, hula-hoop games, and running.
